Remit for consideration at the 2023 Annual General Meeting of the American Classic Car Club

It is important and a useful exercise to regularly review the organisation rules, therefore at the Annual General Meeting, there is a remit to be considered and if approved will be replacing Rule 3A of the club rules.

Please note that this remit only applies to any new members wanting to join the club. All existing members have been confirmed under the existing membership criteria and therefore do not need to qualify under the proposed remit.

The remit will be open to the floor for discussion and finalised at the AGM. And the final vote will be provided as a secret ballot vote to ensure every vote is counted and that our members can freely vote anonymously.

Currently the rules read as follows:
